**Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981
Determination of 31 Applications for Orders to Modify the Definitive Map and
Statement
of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire by Upgrading Various Routes in Various
Parishes to Byways Open to All Traffic**

You will be aware of various applications submitted to Oxfordshire County Council for a number of routes, currently recorded on the Definitive Map as Restricted Byways, to be recorded as Byways Open to All Traffic.

The evidence in these cases has been assessed and is detailed in the attached report.

The Council has determined against all the applications on the basis that any rights for mechanically propelled vehicles were extinguished by the Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act 2006.

Copies of all 31 Notices of Determination are attached and I apologise that not all of these will be of relevance to you.

Therefore, no Orders will be made to modify the Definitive Map and Statement, although the applicants have a right to appeal these decisions to the Planning Inspectorate within 28 days.
