

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**The Oxfordshire County Council
Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire
Mixbury Bridleway No. 33 Modification Order 2019**

On the 24 May 2019, Oxfordshire County Council confirmed without modification the above order made under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by: -

Adding to them the bridleway from bridleway 4 at the dismantled railway at grid reference SP 6166 3519, east-south-east for approx. 143 m to SP 6180 3516, continuing south-east for approx. 847 m to the Buckinghamshire County Boundary at SP 6256 3479.

The order as confirmed became operative on the date of confirmation but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, on the ground that it is not within the powers of section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of Schedule 15 to the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the Act, within 42 days from 6 June 2019, make an application for that purpose to the High Court.
