

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER  
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**The Oxfordshire County Council Addition of Restricted Byway No 20  
(including the Upgrading of Footpath No 9 (Parts))  
Parish of Chalgrove Modification Order 2019**

The above Order made on 19 December 2019, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:

Recording a restricted byway from the junction with High Street and The Green, Chalgrove at grid reference SU 6367 9691 (point A on the Order Plan), south-south-west for approximately 280 metres to SU 6358 9666 (point D) at the junction with Chalgrove FP21 and then south-east for approximately 120 metres and then east for 10 metres to the church yard of St Mary's Church at SU 6366 9656 (point E on the Plan).

AND

Upgrading from footpath to restricted byway from SU 6366 9685 (point B on the Plan) south-south-west approximately 37 metres to SU 6365 9683 (point C on the Plan) and from SU 6358 9666 (point D on the Plan) south west for approximately 42 metres to the junction with Chalgrove Footpaths 8 and 22 at SU 6355 9663 (point F on the Order Plan).

AND

Varying the particulars of those previously recorded public rights of way affected by the Order.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Oxfordshire County Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the order. If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
