

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

**The Oxfordshire County Council,
Pyrton Footpath No. 9 (part),
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification
Order 2018.**

This Order is made by The Oxfordshire County Council ('the authority') under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the landowner crossed by the footpath described in Article 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr B and Mrs J Schofield have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

South Oxfordshire District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the Highways Act 1980.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Pyrton and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished from the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
2. There shall be from the date of confirmation a public footpath over the land situated at Pyrton (as described in Part 2 of the Schedule) and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire shall be modified by adding that right of way to it, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
3. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in Article 1 above shall have the following

rights over the land referred to, namely: they shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the extinguishments took place.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING WAY

The entire width of Pyrton Footpath No. 9 that runs from Knightsbridge Lane at OS Grid Reference SU 6877 9607 (Point A on the Order plan) south-westwards past 'The Plough' for approximately 20m to SU 6876 9606 (Point B).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW WAY

A new footpath with a width of 2m that runs from Knightsbridge Lane at OS Grid Reference SU 68763 96102 (Point C on the Order plan), south-westwards for approximately 20m to SU 68748 96088 (Point D), generally south-eastwards through SU 68759 96075 (Point E) and south-south-westwards for approximately 27m to SU 6876 9606 (Point B).
