

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Section 257/261
The Oxfordshire County Council Sutton Courtenay Footpath No 12 (part)
Public Path Temporary Diversion Order 2019

This Order is made by the Oxfordshire County Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert temporarily, as permitted by section 261 of the Act, the footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely:

"To continue development permitted by Planning Permission P14/V0479/CM (for the deposit of non-hazardous waste including surcharging the existing landfill, extending the duration of landfill and clay extraction operations, temporary storage of PFA and ancillary activities to restoration) without conditions 1, 10,15,17, 28, 30, 32 and 34, to amend the landfill phasing, restoration plan for phase 3, restored contours of Phase 3 and the restoration method for Phase 3 and 4 at Sutton Courtenay Landfill Site, Appleford Siblings, Sutton Courtenay (Planning Application No MW.0039/15. Planning Permission ref P15/V0530/CM).

The definitive line of the said footpath is as described in Part A of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule").

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part A of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted temporarily as provided below.
2. The footpath shall be diverted temporarily over the land shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order and described in Part B of the Schedule.
3. The temporary diversion of the bridleway shall have effect on the date of confirmation of the Order.
4. The temporary diversion shall cease to have effect on 31st December 2029 or on the date when the Oxfordshire County Council certifies that the footpath has been restored to a condition that is fit for public use along its definitive line, whichever is the earlier.
5. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in Article 1 above shall have the following rights over the land referred to, namely: they shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the extinguishments took place.

SCHEDULE

PART A

DESCRIPTION OF SUTTON COURTENAY FOOTPATH 12 (PART)

The entire width of Footpath No 12 that runs eastwards for approximately 659m across the Sutton Courtenay Landfill Site from OS Grid Ref SU 5130 9387 (Point A on the Order plan) to the B4016 Appleford Road at SU 5195 9388 (Point B).

PART B

DESCRIPTION OF TEMPORARY DIVERSION OF SUTTON COURTENAY FOOTPATH 12(PART)

A footpath with a width of 2m that follows the outer edge of the Sutton Courtenay Landfill Site from OS Grid Ref SU 5130 9387 (Point A on the Order Plan) generally northwards for approximately 237m to SU 5134 9410 (Point E), eastwards for approximately 162m to SU 5150 9409 (Point F), north-eastwards for approximately 110m to SU 5159 9414 (Point G), south-eastwards (and running parallel with the B4016) for approximately 357m to SU 5190 9399 (Point H) and south-south-eastwards for approximately 120m to SU 5195 9388 (Point B).

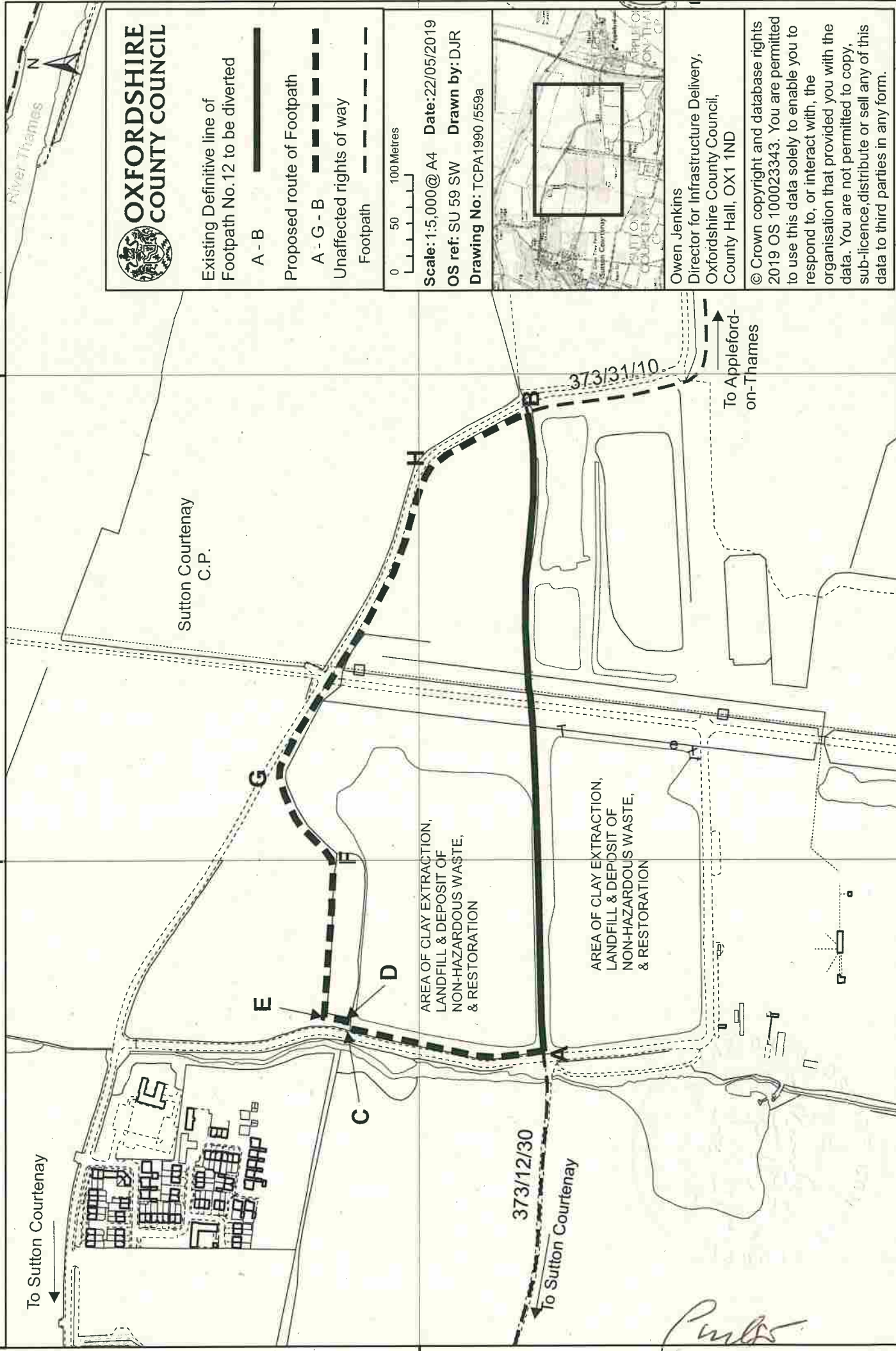
