

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, BANBURY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF
WAITING AND LOADING) (AMENDMENT NO.**) ORDER 20****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The order further amends the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads, Banbury) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) Order 2002. The effects of the order are as follows:

- 1) To introduce/extend 'No Waiting at Any Time' - Double Yellow Lines (DYLs) on **Bankside** into the junctions with the following roads:
 - a) Coppice Close; Meadow View, Wood End; Bridle Close; Spinney Drive; Farm Way; Chatsworth Dive (north and south junctions); Newbold Close,
 - b) On High Acres the existing on-carriageway restrictions will be formalised.

- 2) To introduce/extend 'No Waiting Mondays to Saturdays 8am to 6pm' in the following parts of **Bankside** between High Acres and the roundabout to the A4260 Oxford Road;
 - a) East & southeast side: from south of High Acres to its roundabout junction with the link road to the A4260 Oxford Road,
 - b) Southwest side: between High acres and Coppice Close (layby remains with no restrictions); between Coppice Close and Meadow View; between Wood End and Bridle Close; Between Bridle Close and Spinney Drive (no restrictions in layby); Between Spinney Drive and Farm Way.
 - c) West and northwest side: Between Farm Way and Chatsworth Drive (north end); and between Chatsworth Drive (north) and Chatsworth Drive (south).
 - d) Northwest side: between Chatsworth Drive (south) and new roundabout junction to the Oxford Road.

** This matter was first advertised 22.2.17 but due to the passage of time and to comply with Regulations, it is being reconsulted.*
