

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY  
(BRIGHTWELL-CUM-SOTWELL) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\***

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Brightwell-cum-Sotwell) (Speed Limits) Order 20\*\* and shall come into force on the day of 20\*\*.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. The Oxfordshire County Council (Brightwell-cum-Sotwell) (Speed limits) Order 2017, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Wallingford, A4130 Calvin Thomas Way) (Temporary Speed Reduction) Order 2019 are hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE 1**

20mph Speed Limit.

The whole length of every road in the village of Brightwell-cum-Sotwell, extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the said village) to the following points:

a)	Bell Lane		Its northern junction with High Road.
b)	Church Lane		Its northern junction with High Road.
c)	Didcot Road		A point 295 metres east of its junction with the A4130
d)	Greenmere		Its northern junction with High Road.
e)	Slade End		Its northern junction with the A4130.

**SCHEDULE 2**

30mph Speed Limit.

a)	Didcot Road	From its junction with the A4130 eastwards for a distance of 295 metres.
b)	A4130 Wantage Road	<b>from a point 39 145 metres northwest of the junction with Slade End south-eastwards for a distance of 171 277 metres</b>
c)	High Road (south of A4130)	For its entire length.
d)	Sires Hill (partly in the Parish of Little Wittenham)	From its junction with Long Wittenham Road eastwards for a distance of 675 metres.
e)	Wallingford Road (partly in the Parish of Warbough)	From its junction with the A4074 Henley Road in Shillingford, southwards for a distance of 1168 metres.

**40mph Speed Limit SCHEDULE**

<b>A4130 Calvin Thomas Way</b>	<b>from a point 110 metres south of its roundabout junction with Wantage Road, Southwards</b>	<b>to its junction with the Hithercroft Road roundabout, a distance of approx. 1,350 metres, partly in the Parish of Wallingford</b>
