

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WALLINGFORD, A4130 CALVIN THOMAS WAY)
(TEMPORARY TURN RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2019**

WHEREAS the Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) is satisfied that the vehicular traffic should be temporarily restricted in part of the A4130 because of site development related work (“the Works”) to be carried out in the road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Save as provided by Article 2 of this Order no vehicle entering the A4130 Calvin Thomas Way from the adjacent building sites shall, when appropriate signage is in place make other than a left turn southwards (“the Section of Road”).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply, having regard to the progress of Works, if the vehicle is being used for any of the following purposes:
 - (1) Police, fire and ambulance services in an emergency,
 - (2) the Works.
3. The prohibition imposed by Article 1 shall apply in relation to any part of the Section of Road to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs (within the meaning of Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Wallingford, A4130 Calvin Thomas Way) (Temporary Turn Restrictions) Order 2019 and shall have effect from 2 December 2019 for eighteen months or until the Works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
