



## **SOUTHAMPTON STREET & BERNER'S WAY (FARINGDON) PROPOSED SHARED-USE CYCLE TRACK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to construct the following features on **Southampton Street** and **Berner's Way** in Faringdon to help improve pedal cyclist safety in the area:

- Shared-use cycle track:
  - Southampton Street – from the southern side of Ferndale Street, southwards on the footpath link to Southampton Street for 21\* metres.
  - Berner's Way – on the footpath leading west from the western most point of Berners Way for a distance of 20\* metres.

\* All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the feature.

The County Council will consider any objections and representations received in response to this Notice. They may be disseminated widely for these purposes and made available to the public.
