

**GREENWOOD WAY AND SIR FRANK WILLIAMS AVENUE,
DIDCOT:
PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSINGS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to construct two Zebra crossings (a crossing for use by pedestrians) at the following locations to help improve pedestrian safety in the area:

- **Greenwood Way** - approximately 75* metres north of its junction with Fen Violet Drive.
- **Sir Frank Williams Avenue** – approximately 17* metres north of its junction with Blackthorn Road.

(*All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the crossing.)
