**NOTICE OF MAKING OF ORDER
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER,
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**The Oxfordshire County Council,
Hook Norton Footpath 11 (part) and Hook Norton Footpath 12 (part),
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2020.**

In January 2020 Oxfordshire County Council consulted a wide range of consultees regarding a proposed diversion of the above public rights of way. No Objections were received.

Following those consultations, on 27th April 2020 the Oxfordshire County Council made the above Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The Order, if confirmed, will divert the public paths as described and shown in the Order.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Order and Notice publicising the Order for your information. Also enclosed is a statement which explains the background to the proposal, the reasons for making the Order and how objections or representations may be made.

Please note that this is NOT a legal change to the rights of way network at this stage. Only if the Order is confirmed and comes into effect will the Definitive Map be changed.
