



## OXFORD ROAD (LITTLEMORE, OXFORD) PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to construct the following traffic calming features on **Oxford Road** in Littlemore to help improve pedestrian safety in the area:

- Traffic calming features comprising of **Five Flat Top Humps with Uncontrolled Crossing Points** (with ramp heights of 75mm & gradients of 1:10) to be located at the following locations:
  - 32m south of its roundabout junction with the Eastern By-Pass Road, to be approx. 6m wide,
  - 78m south of its roundabout junction with the Eastern By-Pass Road, to be approx. 6m wide
  - at its junction with Swinbourne Road, to be approx. 20m wide
  - 44m south of its junction with Swinbourne Road, to be approx. 9m wide, and
  - at its junction with Dudgeon Road, to be approx. 20m wide

\* All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the feature.
