

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ISLIP) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2) and 4(2) and Part IV Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Islip) (One-way Traffic) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment

(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa

(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
3. Save as provided in article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle in a road/length of road specified in column 1 of the schedule to this Order to proceed in a direction other than that specified opposite to it [in relation to that road/length of road] in columns 2 & 3 of the schedule,

provided that it shall not be in contravention of this restriction for a person who wishes to use any parking place in the road/length of road to manoeuvre into or out of the parking place by means of forward and reverse gears.
4. Nothing in article 3 shall make it unlawful for a vehicle to be driven contrary to the requirements of article 3 for any of the following purposes:
 - (1) A vehicle of the Police, Fire or Ambulance service being used in an emergency;
 - (2) A vehicle of, or working for the local authority undertaking works to the road.
5. The County of Oxfordshire (Traffic Regulation) Order No.4 1947 is hereby revoked.
