

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GROVE) (DENCHWORTH ROAD AND CANE LANE)
(PROHIBITION MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 & 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Grove) (Denchworth Road and Cane Lane) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. The `Sections of Road` in this order means:
 - (1) Denchworth Road, the superseded/closed section extending 80metres southwards from Newlands Drive;
 - (2) Cane Lane, the superseded/closed section extending approximately 75 metres eastwards from Newlands Drive to the realigned part of Cane Lane.
3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
4. Save as provided by article 5 of this order no person shall, except with the consent or under the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the Sections of Road specified in article 2 of this order.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the Sections of Road if it is necessary for the vehicle to be used for Police, fire or ambulance services, or works to utility services and highways.
