

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION AND COMING INTO OPERATION  
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257  
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14

**Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Section 257,  
The Oxfordshire County Council Hanborough Unrecorded Footpath,  
Public Path Stopping Up Order 2021**

On 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Oxfordshire County Council confirmed the above Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to stop up 94m of unrecorded Hanborough Footpath running eastwards through the Hanborough School site from OS Grid Reference SP 4200 1400 to SP 4209 1402, and 33m of the unrecorded footpath running southward through the site from SP 4204 1401 to SP 4205 1398 **and** create a new 226m line running outside the Hanborough School site perimeter from Reily Close at SP 4211 1409 southwards to SP 4212 1403, westwards to SP 4209 1402, south-westwards to SP 4207 1399, westwards to SP 4205 1398, southwards to SP 4206 1394, westwards to SP 4204 1394 and then southwards to a pedestrian gap in the south wall of the pavilion access to join the southern side of Pinsley Road at SP 4204 1392 as shown on the Order plan.

It is not possible to view the Order at local council offices as they are temporarily closed due to the COVID 19 pandemic. A copy of the Order and Order plan is available

The Order as confirmed came onto operation on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 **within six weeks from the 25<sup>th</sup> March 2021**.
