**The Oxfordshire County Council,
Unrecorded Footpath No 19, Chadlington
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification
Order 2020**

This Order is made by The Oxfordshire County Council ('the authority') under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the landowner crossed by the footpath described in Article 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The owner of the land crossed by the footpath has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

West Oxfordshire District Council has been consulted as required by Section 26(3) of the Highways Act 1980.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Chadlington and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished on the date upon which the Oxfordshire County Council certifies that the route described in Part 2 of the Schedule has been brought into a fit condition for the use by the public.
2. There shall be from the date of confirmation a public footpath over the land situated at Chadlington (as described in Part 2 of the Schedule) and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire shall be modified accordingly, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
3. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in Article 1 above shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the date of this Order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING WAY

The entire width of unrecorded footpath running NE from the public highway leading to Lower Court Farm at OS Grid Reference SP 3243 2130 (Point D on the Order plan) for approximately 170m to Chadlington Fp 5 at SP 3256 2141 (Point C).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW WAY

A new footpath with a width of 3m running NE from the public highway leading to Lower Court Farm at OS Grid Reference SP 3242 2132 (Point E on the Order plan) for approximately 170m to Chadlington Fp 5 at SP 3256 2141 (Point C).

PART 3

Limitations and Conditions

The right of the owner to erect and maintain a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SP 3244 2134 (Point F).

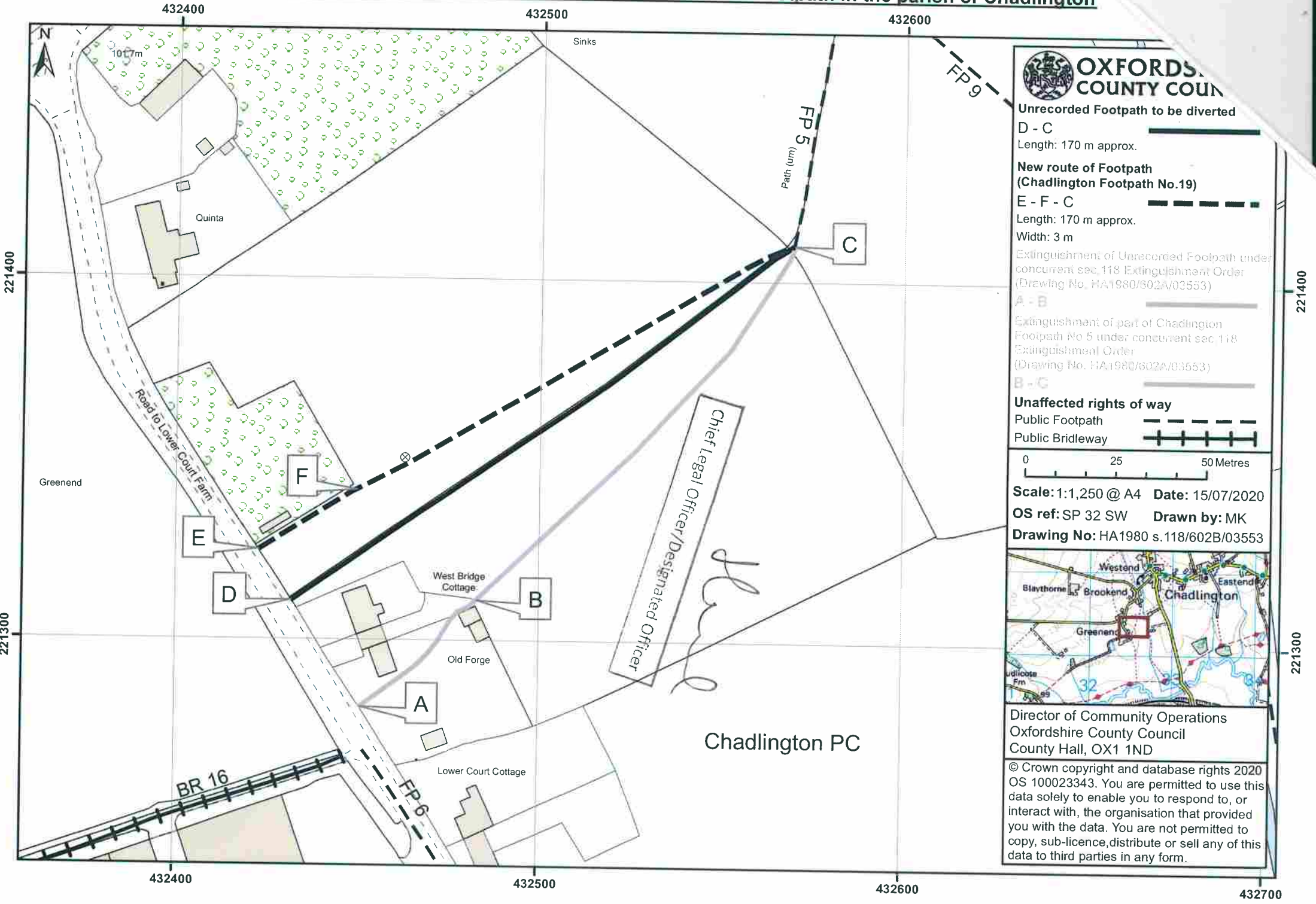
