

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire
The Oxfordshire County Council
Spelsbury Footpath No. 12 (part) Modification Order 2021**

The above Order made on 17 March 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by: -

Adding to them the footpath continuing from grid reference SP 3584 2196 in a generally north-east, then easterly direction for approximately 33 metres to SP 3587 2198 then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 35 metres to SP 3586 2201 then continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 25 metres to SP 3586 2204, then running generally east for approximately 57 metres to the junction with the unclassified highway at Taston Cross as shown on the List of Streets at SP 3592 2205.

If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
