

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS - SOUTH OXFORDSHIRE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMITTED PARKING) (VARIATION No.\*\*\*) ORDER 20\*\***

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The order will amend the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads - South Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) Order 2021 with the effect of extending double yellow lines (No Waiting at Any Time) in:

1. Reading Road (approximately 300 metres south of St Johns Road) – to its junction with Orchard Close. The restriction will also continue 20 metres into the new junction. As part of the Winterbrook development a new access junction into the development is being constructed on the east side and the aim is to prevent potentially dangerous parking at that point.
  
2. Charter Way – on the east side between Meriden Court and Borough Avenue. This is associated with adjacent development of social housing and formalises the double yellow lines currently marked.

\* This is a repeat of the same consultations which were approved in 2019 but have since `timed out` after 2 years in March & June 2021 respectively due to development delays.
