1. (OXFORD, MARSTON NORTH AREA) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.2) ORDER 20**
2. (VARIOUS STREETS OXFORD) (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.***) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 20**
3. (ELSFIELD ROAD AND OXFORD ROAD, MARSTON) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the proposal is to extend the existing Marston North Controlled Parking Zone by incorporating the following roads: Barns Hay, Boults Close, Boults Lane, Church Lane, Elsfeld Road, Harlow Way, Little Acreage, Lodge Close, Mill Lane, Oxford Road, Park Way, Ponds Lane and Southcroft.

1) Waiting Restrictions:

- (a) 'Prohibition of waiting at any time' (Double Yellow Lines) will see some additions in the following roads: Barns Hay, Elsfeld Road, Oxford Road and White Hart.
- (b) Double Yellow Lines will remain as currently marked in Boults Close and Boults Lane.

2) Parking Places:

- (a) The following roads will include parking places for permit holders only 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday, and for non-permit holders for a maximum of 2 hours applying at all times (no return within 2 hours): Barns Hay, Boults Close, Boults Lane, Church Lane, Elsfeld Road, Harlow Way, Little Acreage, Lodge Close, Mill Lane, Oxford Road, Park Way, Ponds Lane and Southcroft.

3) Traffic Restrictions:

The existing 'Prohibition of Motor Vehicles' on Elsfeld Road between Oxford Road and a point 23 metres east of Southcroft will be amended to allow access to that section of road for permit holders & 2-hour general parking. The remaining short section of Elsfeld Road to its junction with Marsh lane will retain the prohibition in order to prevent unauthorised access.

4) Eligible properties:

Residents of Barns Hay, Boults Close, Boults Lane, Church Lane, Elsfeld Road, Harlow Way, Little Acreage, Lodge Close, Mill Lane (except Hill View Farm), Oxford Road, Park Way (Even Nos. 2-24 and Odd Nos 1-21), Ponds Lane and Southcroft will be able to apply for annual parking permits and the eligible properties are known as 'Zone Addresses' with a local identifier 'MA'.

5) Residents permits:

Will be limited to one per resident with a maximum of two permits per property. A resident may obtain a temporary permit for a replacement vehicle while their permanent vehicle is off the road. A person who is temporarily resident at a Zone Address for work purposes will be eligible for a resident's permit. A resident who is temporarily resident for study purpose does not qualify.

6) Visitors permits:

Will be available for residents at the Zone Addresses, usually a maximum of 50 days' worth of permits will be issued per year and provided in blocks of 25. A temporary resident will be entitled to 25 visitors permits.

7) Charges:

(a) for residents permits per property will be £65 per annum. Visitors permits for residents aged 70 or over will be free of charge. For other residents the first block of 25 visitors permits will be free and the second block will be £1 per permit so that the cost of the second block will be £25.

(b) Business permits will be available for businesses (where it is essential for business purposes) within the Zone. Permits will be limited to a maximum of two permits per business and will be vehicle specific. The charge for each will be £150 per annum or £40 for 3 months or £75 for 6 months or £115 for 9 months. The fee for a change of vehicle for business permits is £15.

(c) Contractors may apply for a permit to use a parking place at a charge of £25 for any period not exceeding a week.

(d) Operators of a hotel or guest house located within a Zone address may apply for visitors parking permits. The charge for each will be £1 for 24 hours.

8) Other Matters:

(a) All permits will be Zone specific (MA). A permit may be withdrawn if the permit has not been used in accordance with the provisions of the Order or where it has been abused. This may result in suspension of eligibility for further permits.

(b) Parking places may only be used by vehicles which do not exceed 2.25 tonnes in weight, 2 metres in height (exclusive of any attachments), 5 metres in length and 2 metres in width. Motorcycles may also use designated parking places.

(c) Exemptions to the waiting restrictions and the restrictions on use of parking places will be subject to the following exemptions: For disabled badge holders (maximum of three hours where there is no waiting), loading and unloading, people boarding or alighting, emergency services, universal service providers and vehicles being used in connection with road works and works to the utility services and official funeral vehicles.

(d) the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Marston North Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2021 will be amended accordingly.

(e) The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Streets, Oxford) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2009 (as amended) will be amended so that roads and waiting restrictions are moved from that order into this Proposed Zone order.

(f) The Oxfordshire County Council (Elsfield Road and Oxford Road, Marston) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 1989 will be amended accordingly.
