

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ELSFIELD ROAD AND OXFORD ROAD, MARSTON ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021**

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2) and Part IV Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Elsfield Road and Oxford Road, Marston Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Order 2021 and shall come into force on the day of 20**
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment

(2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Elsfield Road and Oxford Road, Marston Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 1989 is amended in the manner specified in the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

In article 1. of the order the definition of Prohibited Roads is amended as follows:

“Prohibited Roads” means

- 1) Oxford Road, between its junctions with Marston Ferry Road and Elsfield Road,
- 2) *Elsfield Road, from its junction with Marsh Lane to a point 23 metres east of its junction with Southcroft.*
