**NOTICE OF MAKING OF
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**The Oxfordshire County Council Ewelme Footpath No. 32 (part) and
Brightwell Baldwin Footpath No.2 (part),
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2021.**

On 28th June 2021 the Oxfordshire County Council made the above Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The Order, if confirmed, will divert the public paths as described and shown in the Order.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Order and Notice publicising the Order for your information. Also enclosed is a statement which explains the background to the proposal, the reasons for making the Order and how objections or representations may be made.

Please note that this is NOT a legal change to the right of way network at this stage. Only if the Order is confirmed and comes into effect will the Definitive Map be changed.
