

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHILDREY AND SPARSHOLT) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Childrey and Sparsholt Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. The roads specified in Part A of Schedule 1 to this Order are restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Childrey Parish) Order 2000 and the Oxfordshire County Council (Sparsholt Parish) (30 miles per hour Speed Limit) Order 2009 are hereby revoked.

PART A

The whole length of every road in the village of Childrey extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the said village) to the following points:

PART B

Roads in Sparsholt subject to 30 mph speed limit

Broadbrook Lane	from its junction with Sparsholt Street to its junction with Eastmanton Lane;
Church Way	for its entire length between Sparsholt Street and Partridge Way;
Days Avenue	from a point 184 meters north of its junction with the B4507 northwards then eastwards to its junction with Church Way / Westcot Lane, a distance of 363 metres.
Eastmanton Lane	from its junction with Pulpit Hill south for a distance of approximately 135 metres
Partridge Way	from its junction with Church Way southwards for a distance of 15 metres.
Pulpit Hill:	from its junction with Eastmanton Lane eastward for a distance of approximately 90 metres;
Sparsholt Street	from its junction with Watery Lane to a point 60 metres south of its junction with Church Way;
Watery Lane	for its entire length;
Westcot Lane	from its junction with Days Avenue / Church Way northwards for a distance of 419 metres.
West Street	for its entire length.

SCHEDULE 2

40 mph Speed Limit

B4001 New Road and unnamed B4001 road, Childrey

from the A417 Faringdon Road southwards to a point 268 metres west of its junction with Church Row,

Pulpit Hill, Childrey to Sparsholt road

from of its junction with the B4001 westwards to a point 90 metres east of its junction with Eastmanton Lane, Sparsholt.
