- 1. (CHOLSEY AND MOULSFORD) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****
- 2. (ABINGDON) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of order 1. as a result of the development of land adjacent to Wallingford Road in Cholsey and for road safety reasons is to introduce a 20mph speed limit throughout the new development. Also, to provide a Zebra Crossing on Wallingford Road, 17 metres northeast of its junction with the new development at East End. Order 2. is an administrative update only to the scheduling of local speed limits. There is no change to speed limits on the roads.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Cholsey and Moulsoford) (Speed Limits) Order 2012, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Abingdon) (Speed Limits) Order 2019 will be revoked / replaced.
