## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

As a result of the development of land adjacent to Wallingford Road in Cholsey, the County Council is proposing, for road safety reasons, to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the new development and provide a Zebra Crossing, located on Wallingford Road, north east of its junction with the new development at East End.

Order 2. is an administrative update only to the scheduling of local speed limits. There is no change to speed limits on the roads.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Cholsey and Moulsoford) (Speed Limits) Order 2012, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Abingdon) (Speed Limits) Order 2019 will be revoked / replaced.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measure is aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised whilst facilitating the effective and safe passage of traffic.
