## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CUXHAM WITH EASINGTON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\*

### STATEMENT OF REASONS

Oxfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph speed limit zone throughout Cuxham village.

The proposals are being put forward following road safety concerns raised by the Parish Council, and will see a reduction of the existing 30mph speed limit to 20mph on the main village roads. Traffic calming features will also be introduced throughout the village in order to help with compliance of the new lower speed limit.

The existing 30mph on the un-named road to Brightwell Baldwin west & east of the junction with Turners Green Lane will remain as signed, linking to the existing Brightwell Baldwin speed limit order.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised whilst facilitating the effective and safe passage of traffic.
