

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OXFORD, IFFLEY TURN)
(WIEGHT RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF COACHES) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Iffley Turn) (Weight Restriction and Prohibition of Coaches) Order 200*.shall come into operation on the..... day of20**
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:-
 - “articulated vehicle” means a vehicle with a trailer so attached to it as to be partially superimposed upon it;
 - “Coach” means a motor coach (not being a Bus) being a single deck vehicle used to transport passengers for reward or otherwise,
 - “goods vehicle” means a motor vehicle trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description;
 - “maximum gross weight” means:-
 - (a) in the case of a motor vehicle not drawing a trailer or in the case of a trailer, its maximum laden weight;
 - (b) in the case of an articulated vehicle, its maximum laden weight (if it has one) and otherwise the aggregate maximum laden weight of all the individual vehicles forming part of that articulated vehicle; and
 - (c) in the case of a motor vehicle (other than an articulated vehicle) drawing one or more trailers, the aggregate maximum laden weight of the motor vehicle and the trailer or trailers drawn by it.
 - “Restricted Road” means that part of Iffley Turn on the west side from a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb line of Augustine Way, northwards to a point 38 metres south of the southern kerb line of Cavell Road.

3.
 - (1) Any reference to this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
4. Save as provided by Article 5, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any goods vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 5 tonnes to wait in the `Restricted Road` on any day between the hours of 8.00pm and 7.00am the following day .
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a goods vehicle to wait in such length of road:-
 - (1) if it is being used for police, fire or ambulance services;
 - (2) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any of the following, if it cannot conveniently be so used without proceeding in such length of road:
 - (a) undertaking any building operation, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) moving any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) undertaking works in relation to any sewer or water main or in relation to the supply of gas, water, electricity or communication services;
 - (d) undertaking works in relation to the length of road, a traffic sign or road lighting;
 - (e) carrying out any statutory functions of a local authority;
 - (f) for the purposes of loading or unloading at property in the Restricted Road.

6. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any Coach to wait in the `Restricted Road` on any day between the hours of 8.00pm and 7.00am the following day .
