## Why are we making changes?

The council needs to save more than £6 million on supported transport. We can save money by running services more efficiently, but savings also have to come from reducing the community subsidies and Dial-a-Ride service. Oxfordshire County Council subsidises over 100 bus services in our county, which makes up around 9% of the bus network, so the proposals in the subsidised bus and Dial-a-Ride consultation may affect one in ten bus users and all Dial-a-Ride users.
