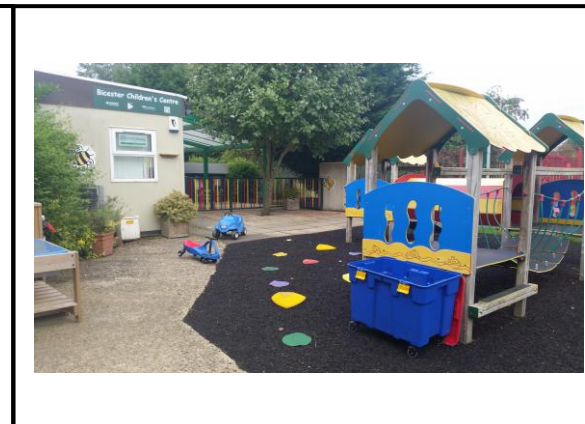

Family Drop in	Drop-in activities open to all	4800
