

**BANBURY, BANKSIDE:  
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES COMPRISING THE  
PROVISION OF SPEED CUSHIONS AND HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to construct on Bankside, Banbury the following traffic calming measures under the Highways Act 1980 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

- A zebra crossing:
  - constructed on a flat top road hump (height 75mm, length 9m, with ramp gradients of 1:15, centred on a point approx. 30m north-west of its junction with Spinney Drive.
- Pairs of speed cushions (approximately 1.6m wide, 2.5m long and 75mm high) spaced 80m apart at the following approx. locations:

1)	65m east of its junction with Hightown Road
2)	40m north west of its junction with Newbold Close
3)	45m south east of its junction with Newbold Close
4)	55m north west of its junction with High Acres
5)	30m south east of its junction with High Acres
6)	25m south east of its junction with Coppice Close
7)	30m south east of its junction with Meadow View
8)	15m north west of its junction with Wood End
9)	20m south east of its junction with Bridle Close
10)	45m south east of its junction with Spinney Drive
11)	20m south of its junction with Farm Way
12)	100m south of its junction with Farm Way
13)	170m north of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (north)
14)	100m north east of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (north)
15)	25m north east of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (north)
16)	55m south west of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (north)
17)	135m south west of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (north)
18)	115m north east of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (south)
19)	35m north east of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (south)
20)	45m south west of its junction with Chatsworth Drive (south)

\* The existing traffic calming chicanes will be removed.
