

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(OXFORDSHIRE 7.5 TONNE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT RESTRICTION)  
(AMENDMENT No.6) ORDER 20\*\***

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 2(4) & 3 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order:

This order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.6) Order 20\*\* shall come into operation on the                    day of                    20\*\*.

1. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.  
(2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.  
(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article bearing that number in this Order.
2. The County Council is satisfied under Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that on the grounds of reducing danger to persons or traffic, preventing damage to roads or buildings on or near the road, facilitating the passage of traffic, and preserving or improving amenities of the area by restricting the amount of heavy goods vehicles, that such heavy vehicles should be prohibited.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) Order 2007, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.1) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.2) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.3) Order 2010, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.4) Order 2014, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxfordshire 7.5 tonne Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) (Amendment No.5) Order 2014 (“the 2007 Order”) shall be amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## **SCHEDULE**

In Schedule 2 of “the 2007 Order” item 4 is deleted and replaced as follows:

“4 “Burford,Upton & Signet:

*A361 Burford: (The Hill, High Street and Barns Lane)*

*A361/A40 Burford roundabout northwards into A361 The Hill, Burford*

*A361/A40 Burford roundabout north-eastwards into Barns Lane, Burford*

*A361/A424 Fullbrook roundabout southwards into A361 High Street, Burford*

Sheep Street, Burford to Upton road:

from its junction with A361, High Street to a point approximately 178 metres northeast of its junction with the A40 Oxford to Cheltenham road, a distance of approximately 1618 metres;

Witney Street, Burford to White Hill:

from its junction with the A361, High Street, Burford to its junction with the A40 Oxford to Cheltenham road.”
