

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHECKENDON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order is 1) to implement a **20mph Speed Limit** in part of Main Road in place of the current 30mph limit (from a point 232 metres south of Whitehall Lane for 345 metres), and 2) to introduce a **30mph Speed Limit** on part of Exlade Street in place of the national (60mph) speed limit (from a point 345 metres southeast of Main Street for 500 metres).

The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Checkendon Parish) Order 1999 will be revoked/replaced.
