

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CASSINGTON, HORSEMERE LANE)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), (2) & 92 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Cassington, Horsemere Lane) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicle) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.

1. The Section of Road specified in this order means that part of Horsemere Lane from its junction with the A40 Oxford to Eynsham road, northwards to its junction with Bell Lane, a distance of 235 metres.
2. Save as provided by article 3 to this order no person shall, other than under the direction, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or the Council cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the Section of Road specified in article 1 of this order.
3. Nothing in article 2 to this order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the Section of Road if the vehicle is being used for any of the following purposes:
 - (1) Police, fire and ambulance services in an emergency,
 - (2) For any eventuality or works by or on behalf of the area offices of West Oxfordshire District Council or Oxfordshire County Council, or any contractor authorised by them.
