## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

In order to improve road safety and to reduce conflict with traffic on the A40 east of Cassington, the County Council is proposing to prohibit the use of Horsemere Lane by motor vehicles between Bell Lane and the A40. The One-Way restriction and the 5t weight limit will be revoked.

The County of Oxford (Horsemead Lane, Cassington) (One Way) Order 1967 and The County of Oxford (Weight Restriction) (Horsemead Lane, Cassington) Order 1961 will be revoked.

The County Council continues its responsibility for the provision of convenient and safe movement of vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measure is aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised whilst considering the needs of different classes of traffic.
