

**FOXHALL ROAD / STATION ROAD (DIDCOT) -
CONVERSION OF EXISTING FOOTWAYS TO SHARED USE FOOTWAY/ CYCLE
TRACK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to – as part of the Science Vale Cycle Network programme - construct the following feature to help improve pedestrian and pedal cyclist safety in the area:

- A Shared-use cycleway at the following location:
 - **Foxhall Road** * - on the eastern footway north of the B4493 roundabout junction, northwards to a point opposite the junction with the access to Didcot Plant, a distance of approx. 70** metres.
 - **Station Road** - on the northern footway east of the B4493 roundabout junction, south-eastwards for a distance of approx. 50** metres to the existing NCN Cycle route.

* The conversion of Foxhall footbridge to shared use is subject to Network Rail approval.

** All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the feature.
