NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The order will further amend the articles to the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Bus Lanes, Cycle Lanes and Traffic Management) Order 2006, the (A4165 Kidlington Roundabout to Oxford City and A44 Peartree Park and Ride to Wolvercote Roundabout) (Bus Lanes and Traffic Management) Order 2008, and the (A4260 Kidlington) (Bus Lane) Order 2006.

It is proposed to permit use of the Oxford area Bus Lanes to include marked `**Blood Bikes**` and other similarly marked vehicles for the urgent delivery of blood related products for use in health care. The vehicles are equipped with blue lights for safety but not permitted to exceed speed limits. Vehicles are operated by: SERV OBN Blood Bikes, Sunny Bank, High Street, Ramsden, Chipping Norton, OX7 3AU.
